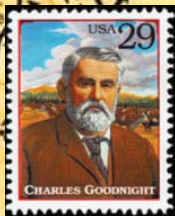

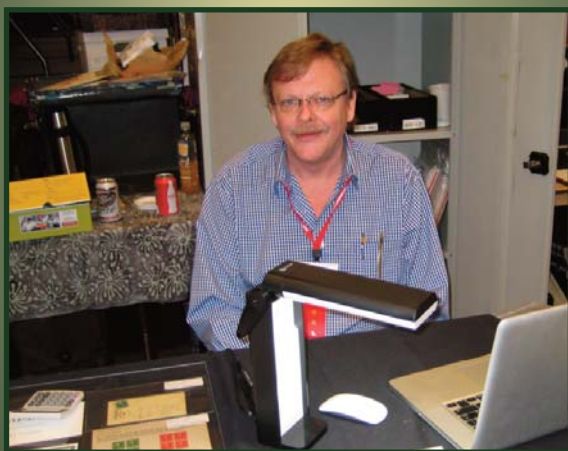

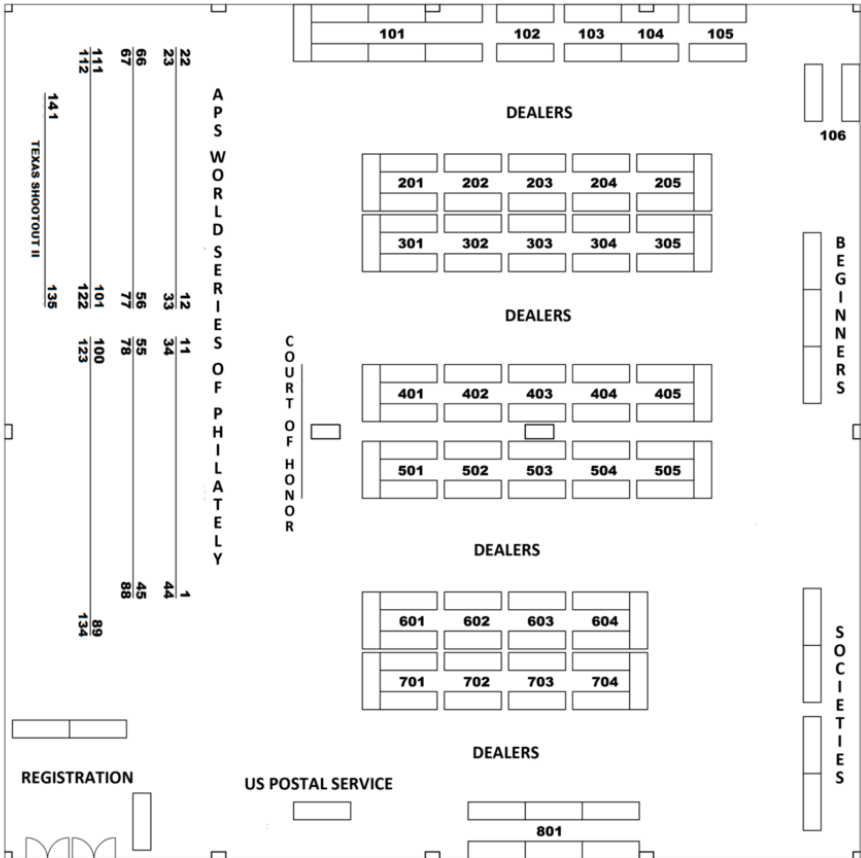

A special feature of TEXPEX 2016 is a spectacular six-panel display illustrating the trials and tribulations of military mail to and from Texas during the Civil War that was produced by the Grapevine, Texas Convention and Visitors Bureau. The panels will be on display all three days of the free show in the Texas Grande Hall.

They cover the fall of New Orleans and the Federal blockade of the western Gulf of Mexico, through the capture of Galveston by the North, the recapture of Galveston, the Battle of Sabine Pass, prisoners of war in Texas, Union Gen. Banks' Expedition to the Texas Coast, the end of the war and the beginning of Reconstruction – altogether a marvelous display of Civil War postal history in Texas.

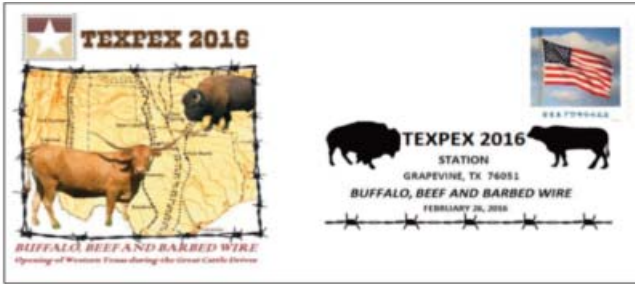

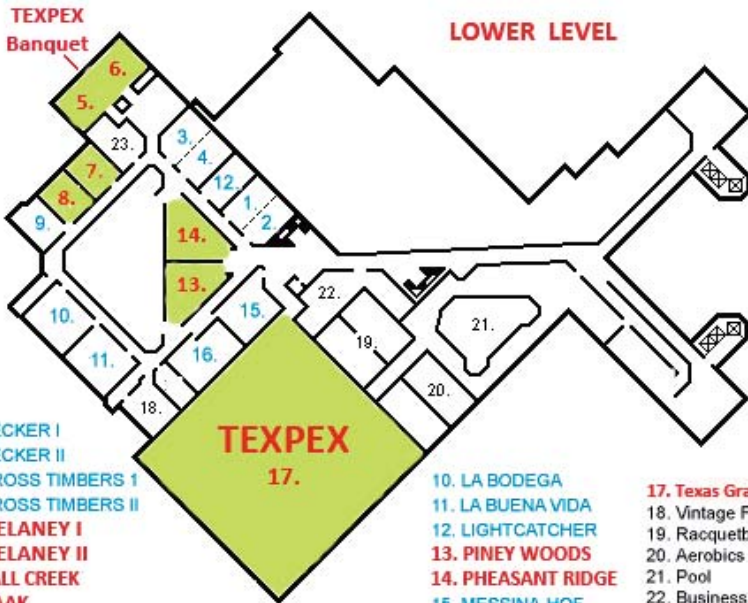
